State Bar Goal: 2b. Increase active volunteer participation in State Bar of Wisconsin programs

**GLD Priority:
Strengthen the Government Lawyers Division by strategically aligning with and engaging government lawyer organizations**

**GLD Goal:
Increase government lawyer member involvement in GLD activities by at least 5% each year by 2012**

Action Steps

1. Establish baseline of current programs serving government lawyers. (07-30-09)
 - Task a: Create list of all programs and services for government lawyers
2. Annually evaluate programs to determine viability of continuation (including participant levels and identification of new service areas. (09-30-09)
3. Annually review strategic alliances with other government lawyer organizations to determine new partnerships. (10-30-09)
 - Task a: Designate GLD board liaisons to at least three (3) of the following:
 - Administrative and Local Government Law Section
 - Public Defenders Association
 - Wisconsin Association of State Prosecutors
 - Wisconsin State Attorneys Association
 - Family Court Commissioners Association
 - Child Support Attorneys Association
 - Wisconsin Corporation Counsel Association
 - Task b: Develop and implement recruitment strategy
4. In cooperation with the State Bar, design new opportunities to engage government lawyers (06-30-2010)
 - Task a: Present at least two (2) CLE programs of interest to government lawyers per fiscal year (through SBW CLE & at Convention) (06-30-2010)
 - Task b: Encourage continued participation of at least two (2) current members on the GLD board. (06-30-2010)

- Task c: Maintain GLD list serves, keeping current with appropriate GLD practice areas of law (06-30-2010)
 - Task d: Promote government lawyer participation in the leadership of the State Bar of Wisconsin (SBW) (06-30-2010)
 - Task e: Work with the SBW, identify Pro Bono activities for government lawyers
 - Study feasibility of developing a Wisconsin GLD pro bono policy model
5. In collaboration with SBW Government Relations Department provide solutions to competitive challenges
- Task a: Develop strategies to inform policy makers of current economic struggles of practicing attorneys
