



## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** That pursuant to s. 73.01(4)(b), Stats., and interpreting s. 73.01(5), Stats., the Wisconsin Tax Appeals Commission will hold a public hearing at its offices located at 5005 University Avenue, Suite 110, in the City of Madison, Wisconsin, on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2008, at 10:30 a.m., to consider certain proposed changes to the Commission's rules of practice and procedure in Chapter TA 1 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code.
