As a part of that commitment, the Section actively supports the annual Wisconsin Solo Small Firm Conference presented by the State Bar of Wisconsin PINNACLE®.

Because the Section recognizes that the conference cost can be a barrier to the professional development of some members, the Section has committed to provide scholarship grants to offset the registration cost of the conference. Preference for the scholarships will be given to solo practitioners and small firm attorneys who would otherwise be unable to attend the conference due to financial constraints.

 Scholarship recipients will be asked to contribute the mission of the Solo/Small Firm and General Practice Section through future volunteer service to the Section by assisting with conference planning, submitting a blog post or article to the newsletter and/or serving on either the Section Board or a Board subcommittee.

We encourage attorneys who find that a financial hardship is a significant factor in preventing them from attending the conference to submit the attached application to request a grant to cover the conference fees. Please note that the scholarship will cover registration fees only and cannot be used for other expenses.

All requests will be treated confidentially. No requests will be considered after the deadline or considered retroactively. Timely requests will be evaluated based on the application criteria and not solely on financial hardship. The Solo/Small Firm and General Practice Section Board reserves the right to consider any factors which it deems appropriate.
