SENTENCING CONSIDERATIONS

As indicated on the relevant matrix, third offense OWI with passenger in vehicle is now a felony offense. A fourth offense OWI is also a felony.

Driver's safety plan is required in all cases. Plan may have victim awareness component including effect on victim and victim's family.

Forfeitures and fines may be reduced in cases of inability to pay with reduction in amount applied to surcharge/plan costs.

Community service must be ordered by the court to reduce the forfeitures and fines if the offender cannot pay the same. The court is to determine amount of reduction in fine for each hour of community service work performed. Sec. 346.65(2g)(ag), Wis. Stats.

Restitution may be ordered by the court.

Site visits to emergency room or alcohol treatment facility may be ordered by the court.

Demerit points are assigned by the DMV in all cases.

Huber privileges are not available unless the offender complies with Alcohol Surcharge, Ignition Interlock orders and Driver's Safety Plan. (Exception for offender who cannot comply because of insufficient funds to obtain surcharge). Sec. 303.065(2m), Wis. Stats.

INGITION INTERLOCK

Required for all offenses except for 1st offense OWI where BAC is under .15.

Applicant must comply with all requirements of the use of vehicles equipped with a functioning ignition interlock device if applicant's vehicle(s) were ordered to have the ignition interlock device placed on them under Wis. Stats. 346.65(6)(a), Wis. Stats.

IID may start/end on a different date than revocation as revocation period is extended by the number of days to which the court sentences the defendant to imprisonment in a jail or prison for an offense related to the revocation. Sec. 343.30(1r), Wis. Stats.

AGGRAVATING AND MITIGATING FACTORS

The guidelines suggest what may be appropriate penalties in situations which are either aggravated or not aggravated. The presence or absence of mitigating or aggravating circumstances in each case will dictate into which of the two matrixes the case more readily fits.

If the mitigating factors dominate, then the "Not Aggravated" matrix would seem more appropriate, with the degree of mitigation dictating the choice of what penalties, within the confines of the appropriate grid, ought to be imposed. If the aggravating factors dominate, then that matrix would seem appropriate, with the degree of aggravation dictating what penalty, within the confines of the appropriate grid, should be utilized.

Some examples of mitigating factors are, but not limited to:

- No evidence of unsafe driving other than intoxication
- No Accident
- No injuries
- No or minimal prior offenses in Wisconsin or elsewhere
- Valid driver's license held at time of offense
- No minor passengers or other at risk individuals, i.e. pregnant passengers; individuals with disabilities, etc.

- No evidence of texting or use of electronic devices at time of driving
- Age of any prior OWI/PAC offenses passage of time
- Cooperation with law enforcement
- Responsible efforts to address AODA issues
- Sincere show of remorse
- Extrajudicial penalties incurred (loss of job, etc.)

Some examples of aggravating factors are, but not limited to:

- Driving without valid driver's license, i.e. after revocation, etc.
- Evidence of unsafe driving beyond mere intoxication
- Accident
- Injuries sustained by others
- Property damage sustained by others
- Prior moving violations; Prior uncounted OWI offenses
- Lengthy prior driving record
- Time and location of driving, i.e. high traffic and pedestrian area, school zones, etc.
- Age of prior OWI/PAC offense
- Prior criminal record
- Uncooperative with law enforcement
- Violation of court orders, i.e. driving restrictions, absolute sobriety, etc.
- Violations of custody release monitoring rules
- Missed court appearances
- Lack of remorse
- Lack of efforts to address AODA issues
- Failure to comply with surcharges ordered in the past
- Lack of insurance
- Minor passenger or at risk individuals in vehicle, i.e. pregnant passengers; individuals with disabilities, etc.
