

Domestic Violence Legal Assistance Project

Winnebago County has been selected as the site of a pilot project intended to measure the effect of appointment of counsel in family law cases. A grant of \$100,000 has been awarded by the Wisconsin Director of State Courts Office through funding from the United States and Wisconsin Departments of Justice. This grant is directed to and will be monitored by Christine Ann Domestic Abuse Services.

The grant will pay for attorneys to represent victims of domestic abuse and sexual assault in all family law cases, except adoption, TPR and CHIPS. The grant is for one year and provides for reimbursement at the county rate including reimbursement for incidental expenses. The purpose of the grant is to study the impact of appointing counsel in civil cases.

Training for the project will occur in September of this year, with appointments of counsel commencing at around the same time.
