

Lobby Law Compliance Form

The Wisconsin Ethics Commission states that a State Public Official as defined below, in connection with presenting a talk about state issues, such as a PINNACLE seminar program, may accept reimbursement or payment of actual and reasonable expenses such as travel (mileage), lodging and meals (faculty lunch) paid for or arranged by the State Bar of Wisconsin. State Public Officials reimbursed for such expenses will be included in the State Bar's semiannual report to the Wisconsin Ethics Commission. The law also states that a State Public Official is prohibited however from receiving anything of value such as an honorarium.

State public officials who are subject to lobby law restrictions include:

- Any elected state officials (supreme court justices or appellate or circuit court judges, legislators, 1) legislative employees, district attorneys and executive branch officers elected in state-wide elections)
- 2) Candidates for elective state office
- 3) Legislative employees
- 4) Agency officials (agency officers or employees whose official duties include participation in the development and promulgation of administrative rules - e.g., the upper management of a state agency, members of part-time boards with rule-making authority, etc.)
