
9/65 A Specialized legal service to attorneys

In reply to an inquiry as to whether an attorney may properly offer his services to other attorneys only for research, brief writing, and appellate work, the committee chairman cited Canon 46, as amended in 1956, which states that a lawyer available to act as associate of other lawyers in a particular branch of law or legal service may send to local lawyers and publish in a local legal journal only a brief and dignified announcement of such availability. This announcement must be in a form which does not constitute a statement or representation of special experience or expertise. (9/17/65)
