## 11/76 C Conflict of interest: New member of firm represented adverse party

It would be improper for a firm to represent a party in an action against another party represented by a firm with which a new member of the first firm had previously been employed. The fact that the new member of the firm no longer represents the adverse party and will have nothing to do with the case in the future does not remove the impropriety.
