port now more than ever. When the COVID-19 pandemic hit, the Law Foundation saw a dramatic increase in applications to support charitable and educational programs and projects that promote greater understanding of the law and improvement of the administration of justice here in Wisconsin.

To meet the demand and help address issues caused by the pandemic, the Law Foundation is working hard to increase our funding – but we cannot do it without all of us pulling together.

#### When the Pandemic Hit, the Need for Support Doubled

When the pandemic hit, we saw requests for grants double – as Wisconsin nonprofits fought to stay in business serving their communities. This year alone, through the Truman Q. McNulty Grants, we were able to make a difference to 10 nonprofits, including grants to ABC for Health, to provide guidance during the pandemic to the newly unemployed as to what access they would have to health care. In Crawford County, a grant kept its teen court program going – helping kids stay out of the justice system. In Madison, a Law Foundation grant helped immigrants receive affordable legal representation through the Catholic Multicultural Center.

We were able to respond to these needs because of the past generosity of our donors.

And now, thanks to the Lyons, your donation will go twice as far.

## A Spirit of Service: Steve R. Sorenson Receives Distinguished Service Award

Ask Steve R. Sorenson, and he will tell you: the concept of working as a lawyer in "a spirit of service" is what has guided his career. "That's what my mantra has always been."

Sorenson of von Briesen & Roper in Neenah is recipient of the Wisconsin Law Foundation's 2021 Charles L. Goldberg Distinguished Service Award, which is presented annually in recognition of a lifetime of service to the profession, and service to their communities over the course of their career.

"Steve is an accomplished lawyer, an admired professor, a dedicated public servant, an active community leader, and has held almost every position of leadership in the profession that one can hold," said John Macy, one of several who nominated Sorenson for the award. "Practicing law was never enough for Steve. He had to do much more."

"I'm extremely pleased," Sorenson said of receiving the award," because the State Bar means the world to me. I have devoted most of my entire professional career in service to the State Bar and other bar associations."

#### Small-firm Mentoring, Service to the Bar, Teaching the Next Generation

Prior to law school, Sorenson briefly worked as a journalist and newspaper editor. Following graduation from Marquette University Law School in 1977, Sorenson worked in the Waukesha County District Attorney's office, but soon moved to Ripon. "I wanted to work in a small town, to help the local residents with their legal needs," he said.



Over the past 36 years, he's worked in Ripon as a solo and a small-firm attorney. Sorenson used his small-firm practice to help young lawyers launch their careers. "There are 29 lawyers practicing in east central Wisconsin," he said, whose careers were launched when he gave them their first jobs out of law school.

While he considered himself a generalist, his focus included real estate, water law, and municipal law. "Every small-town lawyer has those as specialties," he said. He also has practiced in family and criminal law. "I've been through them all."

Ten years ago, he transitioned to working in the large firm of von Briesen & Roper. An impetus for the move was to increase his interactions with colleagues with the same level of experience. While he works at a large firm, he works from his Ripon home and remains active in his community. "Now I have the best of both worlds as I look at it," he said. Along the way, he has continued a commitment to teaching – primarily at local technical colleges. Currently, he teaches at Ripon College and UW-Oshkosh. "I love to teach. It's the way you give the message of what the legal system's about," he said. "Give me a roomful of students and I can help them understand how the legal system is an important part of their lives. I teach them about respect for the law – and that if you don't like it, you can change it."

Community service is also a dedicated part of his career. While his participation is too long to list, he has a significant positive impact on such programs as Badger Boys State and Leadership Oshkosh.

#### Dedicated to the Bar

He started his involvement with the State Bar in 1979, through the Communications Committee - a natural fit with his journalism background. Over the next decades, he served in leadership positions on many different State Bar committees and groups. Sorenson was State Bar president 1997-98, served multiple terms on its Board of Governors, including a term as secretary, and on the Executive and Finance committees. He served three terms on the Foundation board and on multiple Foundation committees. He had a hand in developing the Fellows of the Wisconsin Law Foundation. served as president on the Fellows Board of Trustees 2007-08, and served on multiple Fellows board committees.

"I loved bar work and I always have – that's my passion. Why is this award significant to me? It shows that if you put time and effort in, you can make a difference. I try to continue to make a difference."

Currently, he is working with Dean Dietrich in the Senior Lawyers Division to create and present educational programs for the benefit of senior lawyers of Wisconsin. The programs include not only ethics and transitioning out of practice, but substantive law as well.

Ask him about his commitment, and he sees it as a service to his colleagues and to the community. "It's all about service and being willing to serve."

My wife and I believe education is one of the most valuable gifts we can give, and so we have established this Challenge Grant to inspire our friends and colleagues to join in supporting the Wisconsin Law Foundation's support of lawyer agencies and students through the Foundation's McNulty Grants. The lawyer agencies serve and teach people who may not know how to navigate our legal system, and those who often can't afford to hire lawyers.

The student programs are usually mock courts or teen courts. Students learn that the law and the courts exist to settle disputes. They learn to combine law and facts in a logical, coherent, and emphatic case. They learn to see their case in a different light, as painter Claude Monet did with his series of haystack paintings. Students learn the

## McNulty Grants Support Projects and Programs Through Another Year of COVID-19

These days, we are all doing our best to navigate our way through another year of COVID-19. Thanks to the generous donations of our members who saw the need and supported our grants program, the Wisconsin Law Foundation in 2021 was able to award 10 high-impact Truman Q. McNulty grants of up to \$2,350 nonprofit organizations throughout the state.

The Foundation annually awards McNulty grants to charitable or educational programs or projects that promote greater public understanding of the law and improve the administration of justice, and to law-related public service projects that directly impact Wisconsin residents.

At the Catholic Multicultural Center in Madison, a grant from the Foundation helps keep immigrant families together, offering low-cost immigration legal services to more than 300 people.

"This funding truly makes a difference in our program and the lives of the people we serve," said center director Andy Russell in a thank you note to the Foundation.

In 2021, the Foundation awarded a record \$18,835 in grants to 10 organizations that: help children and families, support teen court programs, assist those who can't afford legal representation, and promote public understanding of the law and legal history.

## Your Contribution Makes an Impact

The Foundation grants help the Milwaukee Justice Center (MJC) to serve thousands in Milwaukee who have no lawyer to help them in their civil legal cases. "In the pandemic year of 2020, the MJC assisted over 7,000 people, with the help of many volunteer attorneys, law students, and undergraduate students through our program," said MJC Executive Director Mary Ferwerda. "We truly cannot do this important work without the involvement of and support by groups like the Wisconsin Law Foundation."

Milwaukee's Centro Legal provides legal assistance to those with complex legal issues that impact their families, with the goal of removing legal obstacles for their clients, "so they can establish stable and healthy family environments, remain employed or improve employability, and establish independence and financial stability," says Molly Dobberke Riehle, Centro Legal's executive director. "We would not be able to provide our services without the Foundation's generous contribution."

In Portage County, a Foundation grant helps to support the Legal Eagle Teen Court Program of the Boys & Girls Club of Portage County. "You help us stay connected and committed to our mission – serving all youth, especially those who need us the most," said Executive Director Kevin Quevillon.

## G. Lane Ware Leadership Fund – Leading the Way

At his core, Wausau attorney G. Lane Ware had a lifelong commitment to connecting young lawyers with the State Bar's work.


Lane lead the State Bar as president 1989-90, and later worked with the State Bar to make sure it was identifying, recruiting, training, and supporting leaders for the future. His leadership with the Law Foundation included terms as president, treasurer, and service on several committees. Lane also served on the Fellows Board of Trustees for many years, and was a member of the inaugural Class of Fellows of the Wisconsin Law Foundation in 2000.

Lane was an attorney who cared deeply about his chosen profession and the colleagues he met and mentored along the way. He became a member of the Wisconsin Law

Foundation Heritage Society, upon his passing in June 2014 bequeathed nearly \$10,300 to the Law Foundation to be used to set up a Leadership Fund. In addition, several



of Lane's colleagues and friends, unsolicited, contributed over \$1,000 to the Law Foundation in his honor. These dollars formed the initial corpus for the G. Lane Ware Leadership Fund.

Lane seeded the Leadership Fund, but you – our donors – continue to give to the fund in Lane's memory. Perhaps you give because, similar to Lane, you believe our brightest future will be achieved through qualified and properly trained leaders.

We are proud to announce that the G. Lane Ware Fund has grown substantially over the last six years. Since its inception in 2015, 88 lawyers, eager to start on the path to becoming leaders, have attended the G. Lane Ware Leadership Academy – with more registering now to attend in November.

Lane Ware helped coin the phrase "Lead the Way – Volunteer Today" to market the G. Lane Ware Leadership Fund. Actually, Lane led the way for all of us – and today we know he would be proud of how each of you have believed in and supported the Leadership Fund. Thank you for your generous support.



## Law Foundation Is Proud Donor to Vel Phillips Capitol Statue

Plans for a statue of the Hon. Vel Phillips, a lawyer, judge, and trailblazer for Black women in politics and the legal profession, were officially approved in November 2021 by the State Capitol and Executive Residence Board.

The Wisconsin Law Foundation together with the State Bar of Wisconsin was one of the first organizations to endorse and pledge financial support for the statue, to be placed outside the Wisconsin State Capitol. Together, the State Bar and Law Foundation have pledged \$25,000 on behalf of our 25,000 attorney members.

Phillips used her knowledge and skills as a lawyer to make a fundamental difference in the lives of thousands, said State Bar Executive Director Larry Martin. "She was a pioneer in city and state government, fighting – and winning – for fair and open housing; for civil rights; racial equality and equal justice. It is a legacy that all Wisconsinites can take pride in."
